Meetings regarding the national membership vote

I assisted in the facilitation of several meetings to raise awareness and encourage discussion about the National Open Membership bylaws amendment proposal. Changes to National AAUW's bylaws require 2/3 majority (66.6%) to pass. Across the country, AAUW members voted 65.1% to approve the measure, just shy of passing.
